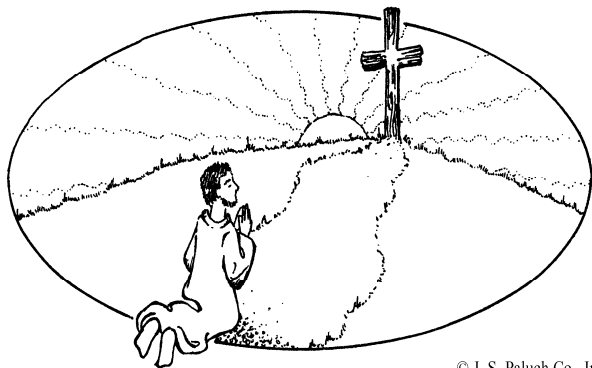

UP COMING EVENTS:

I am ready to say now: "Snow, Snow, go away!" Though Spring is nearly two months away, each day is a new day and I believe that small miracles happen everyday and big miracles happen here at Sacred Heart Parish from time to time. Isn't it a small miracle that nearly two hundred children received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for First time this year whose names are in the bulletin. These small miracles certainly inspired parents to go for confession and that is a good news. From now onwards, these children will be prepared for their First Communion in May, 2009. With this big number, Sacred Heart Parish will make history. We are a happy and God-loving community.

I would like to invite each one of you to participate and actively involve as a parish family in the following celebrations, events and happenings. I need you more than ever, more participation and involvement than an obligation, more prayerful and listening to the Word of God. The Season of Lent is only two weeks away. Mark your calendars, schedule your time and make room for God.

1. Ash Wednesday, February 25th, 2009. Don't come only for ashes! Come for Mass/es. Reflect on the Gospel Message: Repent and Renew. Mass Schedule will be published next week.
2. Stations of the Cross: There will be Stations of the Cross every Friday in Lent at 7:00 p.m. A time to reflect and meditate on the suffering and death of Christ.
3. Soup and Bread: Soup and Bread will be served at 6:00 p.m. every Friday in Lent. There will be varieties of soup and bread but NO MEAT. We need volunteers to help us preparing Soup and buying some bread. I will help washing dishes after the Stations of the Cross.
4. Cardinal's Appeal: February 14 and 15, 2009. Cardinal will speak at all the Masses. We will be broadcasting his homily and message. Please help our Archdiocese generously.
5. Operation Rice Bowl: Deacon Michael Barnish will continue this great ministry: Operation Rice Bowl. He will be preaching at all the Masses on the weekend of February 21 and 22.
6. Last Attempt: We will be making a last attempt to increase pledges and collecting pledges for our Fall Drive 2008. If you have not made any contributions, you still have time to do so. With credit crunch, mortgage debacle and economic crises, many have supported the Sacred Heart Parish. My prayerful Thank You.
7. Cutting and Controlling? Yes, we are prepared to cut and control as much as possible, cost, expenses and loss. The Archdiocese of Chicago has already instructed us to make mandatory Salary Freeze to all the employees for the budget year 2009-10. The Archdiocesan Stewardship Department with the assistance of Diocesan Insurance Company has asked all the parishes to cut cost and minimize expenses. Of course, we will NOT cut or stop any activities or programs and services, but we will be re-organizing them for the benefit of all.
8. I need your prayers as we are making budget for Parish and School for the year 2009-10. It is very much challenging and frightening. Hope your prayers will help us to keep all the programs and services we do and Yes we can, mostly with your voluntary help and support.
9. Finally: I would like to encourage you and urge you to pray devoutly, earnestly, frequently. I have been getting healed much because of your prayers and I am very grateful to you. Because of your prayers and love for me, I am still here and strengthened to serve you. May God bless you.

The Bishop Blasé was martyred in his Episcopal city of Sebastea, Armenia, in 316. Blasé was a good bishop working hard to encourage the spiritual and physical health of his people. Blasé was forced to flee back to his country due to the threat of prosecution, where he lived in solitude and prayer with wild animals. When hunters found Blasé and hauled him off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blasé's command the child was able to cough up the bone. Blasé then was tortured and beheaded.

PROFETAS VERDADEROS

Hoy en Deuteronomio oímos que las palabras de Dios llenarán la boca de un profeta verdadero, pero un profeta falso pondrá, por así decirlo, palabras meramente humanas en boca de Dios. En el Evangelio según san Marcos, vemos a Jesús enseñando y curando como un profeta verdadero con la autoridad de la voz de Dios, el Santo de Dios. Sin duda, hoy existen profetas falsos y verdaderos a nuestro alrededor. La historia de nuestra Iglesia está llena de ambos tipos de profetas. Algunos profetas falsos fueron extremadamente populares y eran muy versados en la Sagrada Escritura, incluso ocupaban puestos de autoridad eclesial. Pero en el Evangelio de hoy descubrimos que la fama de Jesús se extendió porque enseñaba con autoridad; no era una autoridad porque fuera popular o famoso. En otra parte, descubrimos con él, cuando es tentado y enfrenta a Satanás en el desierto, que cualquiera puede citar la Sagrada Escritura para sus propósitos, incluso si estos van en contra de los de Dios. Hoy oímos que su autoridad no era como la de los escribas, que eran la autoridad oficial religiosa en su época. Nuestra tarea es hacer todo lo posible por saber identificar a los verdaderos profetas que están entre nosotros y también a ser verdaderos profetas. El salmista nos dice cómo hacerlo: no debemos endurecer nuestros corazones cuando escuchamos a Dios. Si realmente escuchamos a Dios, Dios pondrá sus palabras en nuestra boca. © Copyright, J. S.
