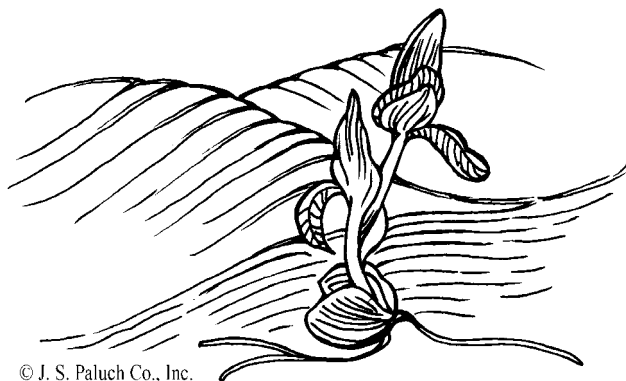

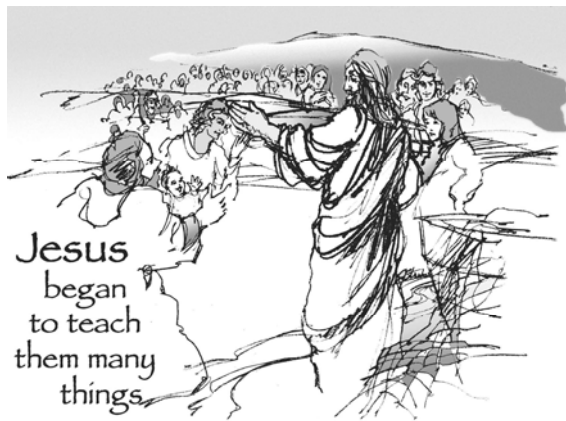

## Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### NOT ME!

Harsh words from Jeremiah today. Or more precisely, harsh words from the Lord, spoken through the prophetic mouth of Jeremiah. Lucky for us that these words are directed at somebody else, those "shepherds" who are misleading the sheep of God's pasture. The shepherds, after all, are those who are in official positions, who hold hierarchical status, or who, at the very least, get paid a salary by the diocese or parish. It is easy enough to point a finger and say that, come to think of it, those shepherds have been misleading the flock lately. But it is perilous to ignore

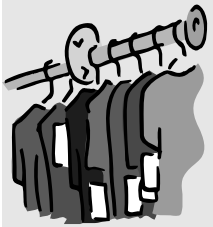
the voice of the Lord on the prophets' lips. The divine will of which they speak applies to everybody, and contains some truth about all of our lives. No matter what we might think our role or place is within the fold, each of us has some responsibility to be a shepherd in daily living. In the smallest acts of justice, charity, or compassion we are living out the call of our covenant with the Lord: to be God's voice, God's presence, God's caring and guiding hand in the world.

### YES, YOU!

The apostle Paul tells us that in Christ we all have access in one Spirit to the Father. With this tremendous and wonderful gift comes the responsibility to make it a gift again for the life of the world. As Christ made peace through the blood of his cross, as he reconciled earth with heaven, we are called to continue that peace-making, reconciling work day by day. Each week we gather with Jesus Christ as the apostles do in today's Gospel. We pray in the Eucharistic Prayer: "May this sacrifice, which has made our peace with you, advance the peace and salvation of all the world." Each of us, baptized into the one Body of Christ, saved by the blood of his cross that we share in one cup, are chosen and called for the mission of shepherding in his name. If we take but a moment to look around, we can easily see that there are many places where people are like sheep without a shepherd. Are our hearts, filled with the presence of the Good Shepherd, moved with pity for them? More important, are our lives moved to action?

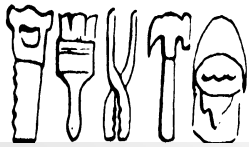

### Maintenance & Building Update... Church Stained Glass Window Repair

As you may have noticed, our stained glass window ventilator panels have been removed for repair. These panels had broken glass, were warped from heat, and had broken and missing lead support bars. The panels will be reinstalled and looking/working like new in about two weeks. The windows have been covered with plywood and **cannot be opened**. Other stained glass windows that will be repaired include the north and south vestibules, sacristy and cry room. The cost of these repairs has been approved for this year's budget by the finance council and pastor, at approximately \$4,955. Thanks for your patience and support.

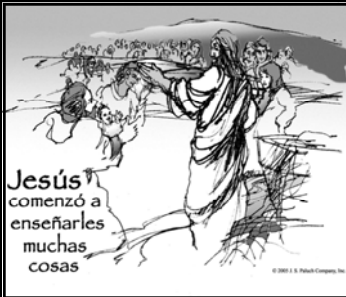

¡YO NO!

Duras palabras de Jeremías. O, más precisamente, duras palabras del Señor, pronunciadas por medio de la boca profética de Jeremías. Suerte para nosotros que esas palabras están dirigidas a otras personas, a esos “pastores” que están confundiendo a las ovejas de Dios. Los pastores, pensándolo bien, son aquellos que tienen puestos oficiales, que tienen una posición jerárquica o que, por lo menos, reciben un salario de la diócesis o la parroquia. Resulta fácil acusar con el dedo y decir que, después de todo, esos pastores últimamente no han guiado bien al rebaño. Pero es peligroso ignorar la voz de Dios en los labios del profeta. La voluntad divina mencionada por el profeta se aplica a todos, y contiene alguna verdad sobre toda nuestra vida. 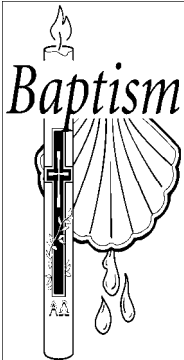
